#### Proposed legislation a crucial step toward reconciliation in BC

We were very pleased to see that Bill C-41 was tabled by the Government of British Columbia. C-41 requires BC to collaborate with Indigenous peoples to develop an action plan and then implement the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples.

BC is poised to create a legal framework to address the legacy of colonialism in provincial laws and policies. Without C-41, laws and policies continue to deny Indigenous peoples and individuals their basic human rights. C-41 would create a collaborative process to ensure that BC laws finally live up to human rights standards.
